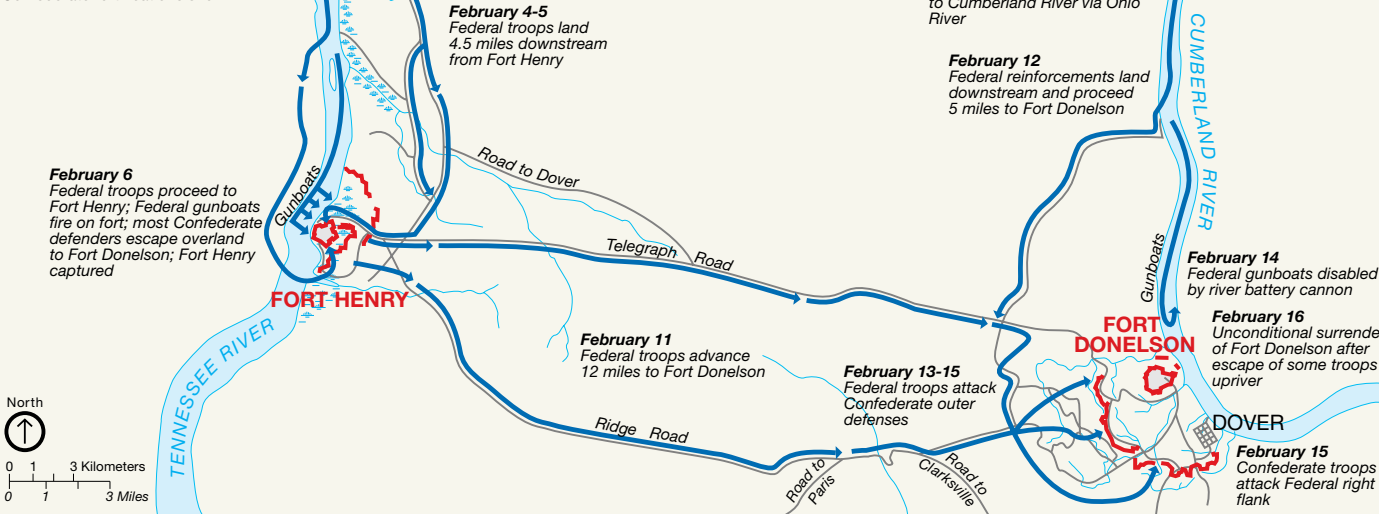


Fort Henry and Fort Donelson Campaign

February 4-5
Federal troops land
4.5 miles downstream
from Fort Henry

February 7-13
Federal gunboats travel from
Fort Henry on Tennessee River to
Cumberland River via Ohio
River

February 12
Federal reinforcements land
downstream and proceed
5 miles to Fort Donelson

February 6
Federal troops proceed to
Fort Henry; Federal gunboats
fire on fort; most Confederate
defenders escape overland
to Fort Donelson; Fort Henry
captured

February 14
Federal gunboats disabled
by river battery cannon

February 16
Unconditional surrender
of Fort Donelson after
escape of some troops
upriver

February 11
Federal troops advance
12 miles to Fort Donelson

February 13-15
Federal troops attack
Confederate outer
defenses

February 15
Confederate troops
attack Federal right
flank
