Introduction addressed to fellow veterans of the Bell-Harmon Post, GAR, Warren, Trumbull County, Ohio.

Part 1. 1864 January-June 16. March to Staunton, Virginia; burning of the Virginia Military Institute at Lexington; destroying railroad during march to Lynchburg.

Part 2. June 17-18, 1864. Battle of Lynchburg, Virginia.

Part 3. June 18-20, 1864. Retreat from Lynchburg.

Part 4. June 20-22, 1864. Continues retreat from Lynchburg to Salem.

Part 5. June 22-July, 1864. Continues retreat; unit marches to Charleston and Parkersburg, West Virginia; train to Martinsburg.
